German astrophysicist **Reinhard Genzel** is co-director of the Max Planck Institute for Extraterrestrial Physics, a professor at Ludwig Maximilian University of Munich and an emeritus professor at the University of California, Berkeley.

He was awarded the **2020 Nobel Prize** in Physics for the discovery of a supermassive black hole in the centre of the Milky Way, which he shared with Andrea Ghez and Roger Penrose.
